My Dear Grandchild

Your welcome letter
of June the 27 received some
time ago and I have been
very sick, hardly able to walk
but I am beginning to get
strong again, the weather has
been fine but cool, but we had
three days of terrible heat, wind
north, that is the hot wind in
the summer. Other times, the
sun is burning, but the air is
cool, I have not seen honey
coming this three weeks, and
all the Bradshaws are gone
up the Slump. There have
now and one in Boncomer

a month, to look at the
 grand new motors, and the
 crowds on the streets you would
 say there was no more, but there
 a million on the lake here
 in Canada, and over 20,000,000
 in the States, we are to have an
 election soon, and I don't know
 what will be the result. we
 will be going into the lake
 next week but will be out again
 in end of august. write often
 and tell me all the fishery
 news, every one seems to be
 tired of writing me, I suppose
 I am too old I send papers
 to you and John every week
 will soon give them up with
 love to all you bring
